

AUTHORIZATION
FOR RELEASE OF PROTECTED HEALTH INFORMATION

I authorize the use and disclosure of my protected health information as described below.

My protected health information is individually identifiable health information, including demographic information, collected from me or created or received by a health care provider, a health plan, my employer, or a health care clearinghouse and that relates to: (i) my past, present, or future physical or mental health or condition: (ii) the provisions of health care to me: or (iii) the past, present, or future payment for the provision of health care to me.

The following individual, organization, or class of person (e.g., group of individuals within the organization) is authorized to use or disclose my protected health information:

I understand that I may revoke this authorization at any time by sending a written notification to the PHP of the Carolinas, and this revocation will be effective for future uses and disclosures of protected health information. However, I further understand that this revocation will not be effective: (i) for information that the Group Health Plan already has used or disclosed, relying on this authorization or (ii) if the authorization was obtained as a condition for coverage in the Group Health Plan and, by law, the Group Health Plan has a right to contest this coverage.

This authorization expires one year from the date of signature.
